- Increase in non-current assets mainly due to ongoing CapEx and fair value gain on equity investments.
- Working capital improved over the previous quarter
- Other equity improved mainly due to fair value gain and profit for the period.

- Revenue remained stagnant compared to the previous quarter and decreased by 20% compared to Q1 PY due to lower realisation and weak demand in the global market amid geopolitical disturbances.
- Lower profitability is attributed to higher fixed costs coupled with reduced sales volume, resulting in inadequate absorption of the entire fixed cost burden.

- Subdued global demand and lower price realisation in the Crop Protection Business resulted in weak performance in the Life Science Chemicals segments.
- Higher inventory and lower capacity utilisation at customer end resulted in lower sales and subsequently profitability in the Performance and Other Chemicals segment.




