Packaging

Lapox B-9 is available in 240 kg MS | HDPE drums and 1,000 kg IBC. Other packing may be considered on request.

Storage and handling

Lapox B-9 should be stored in a cool and dry place, preferably in a sealed container and should not be exposed to direct sunlight. This product has a shelf life of 2 years if stored in its original container between 20°C and 40°C away from humidity and excessive heat. It has a tendency to crystallise if stored below 20°C. Crystallisation can be reversed after heating at 60°C. The recommended pumping temperature is between 70°C and 80°C.

Safety

Wear personal protective equipment (PPE). Avoid contact with the eyes and skin. In case of direct contact and irritation, the resin should be washed off immediately with soap and warm water. Avoid breathing vapours, mist or gas. Please refer to the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) of Lapox B-9 for detailed safety instructions.
