Description

Lapox ARD-54 is a low viscosity, long chain aliphatic diepoxide reactive diluent based on polypropylene glycol. It is compatible with all types of epoxy resin in any proportion. Resins diluted with this product can be suitably cured by epoxy curing agents for variety of applications. Higher proportion imparts flexibility in cured system and hence affects glass transition temperature significantly.

Lapox ARD-54 is available in 200 kg MS | HDPE drums and 1,000 kg IBC. Other packing may be considered on request.

Storage and handling

Lapox ARD-54 should be stored in a cool and dry place, preferably in a sealed container and should not be exposed to direct sunlight. This product has a shelf-life of 2 years if stored in its original container between 2°C and 40°C away from humidity and excessive heat.
